



Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request 2022.0253

On the 15/03/2022 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

We are undertaking a project to establish the use of Stalking Protection Orders between 1st January 2021 and 31st December 2021. To this end, we are writing to ask if, under the auspices of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, you could kindly provide the following information:

1. The number of Interim Stalking Protection Orders applied for and granted during 2021 (01/01/2021 to 31/12/2021)
2. The number of Full Stalking Protection Orders applied for and granted during 2021
3. The number of Stalking Protection Orders breached during 2021

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information. In answer to the questions you posed, I can say the following:

1. One
2. Zero
3. No information held. The Crime Recording System has no crimes recorded under the offence of Breach of Stalking Order/Interim Stalking Order (008/74) in 2021.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
