



Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request 2023.0462

On 25 April 2023 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

Please list the number of serving police officers who gained criminal convictions whilst serving with this force and the nature of the conviction. I would like the figures in the form of a table which gives the total number (not name) of officers convicted of the crime; the type of crime; and whether they are or were on restricted duties as a result of the crime.

On 28 April 2023, you were asked to clarify the date range of this request. On 1 May 2023 you confirmed that you wished the request to consider the previous 5 years of data.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

A search of records held within the Constabulary shows:

Case	Type of crime	Restricted (Y/N)
1	Sexual offences	Y
2	Theft	Y
3	Driving a motor vehicle with excess alcohol	Y

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
