Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request 2023.0210

On 14/02/2023 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

Could you please send reports of collisions/accidents at Frocester Hill, Near Nympsfield since the commencement of January 2022

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Police Forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide statistics to government bodies and the recording criteria is set nationally. However, the systems used for recording these figures are not generic, nor are the procedures used locally in capturing the data. It should be noted that for these reasons the figures given relate to information from the specific recording system of Gloucestershire Constabulary and should not be used for comparison purposes with any other response you receive.

Please note that our systems are designed to record information for policing purposes and the investigation of crime and not to extract statistical information. Accordingly whilst we endeavour to extract relevant data within the time limits of the Act, any data supplied is subject to these limitations.

When an Individual contacts the police (i.e. "reports" an offence) and it is deemed to be a police matter, an incident will be created on the Incident Recording System. The Incident Recording System is very much a free text entry system with several tags/categories.

Due to the way information is recorded and the format of retrieval, it is not possible to provide copies of incident reports. We can, however, provide the call type and the incident description. Please note that the description is a free text field and is completed by the call handler.

A search has therefore been conducted to identify incidents recorded between 01/01/2022 and 13/02/2023 where the location contains "frocester hill" and the call type summary contains either "RTC" or "highway disruption". The results have been listed below –
