Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request 2023.0291

On 09/03/2023 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

Thank you for your email dated 8th March 2023 I have read the answers and there seems to be two matters not addressed.

1. I would like to know how long the constabulary holds personnel files for.
2. I would like to know how long the constabulary holds disciplinary files for.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

I can confirm the following information:

1. Personnel files are kept for 100 Years or until the individual has died.
2. Centurion Records should be kept for the duration of an officers' service plus 6 years.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
