Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request 2023.0318

On 16/03/2023 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

I am getting in touch from ITV National News regarding the use of Non Disclosure Agreements (NDAs) by police forces

Could you please provide the following information?

1. How many Non-Disclosure Agreements have female police officers signed as victims of rape, sexual assault, indecent assault, sexual harassment, harassment and/or bullying as of the last 5 years – per calendar from 2018 up to and including 2022.
Please give a breakdown for each year.
2. How much has your force spent annually on the NDAs outlined in Q1 for the same period?
Please give a breakdown for each year.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Following receipt of your request, I can confirm that searches were carried out with the relevant business area. These have resulted in a nil response for the information which has been requested.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
