Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request 2023.0469

On 27/04/2023 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

1. Have you ever used next generation sequencing DNA to help identify the phenotype of a suspect in a criminal investigation?
2. Have you used the services of Paragon Genomics in 2022 or 2023 to help identify a suspect in a criminal investigation?

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds no relevant information.
