**Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request 2023.0481**

On 01/05/2023 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Please provide me with the following;

- How many officers were convicted of a serious sexual offence between 2016 - 2023?
- How many of these officers subsequently had their pensions withdrawn?
- Please provide a breakdown of these figures by year from 2016 - 2023.
- Please also provide an annual estimated cost of those pensions granted to this group of officers.
