Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request 2023.0680

On 28/06/2023 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

I would like to submit a request to be appraised of the pay banding and role description for the following role, or equivalent in your force;

Child Protection Case Conference Officer

This being the member of staff who attends multi-agency Child Protection Case conferences on behalf of the police to present information and participate in decision making in relation to placement of a child on the Child Protection Register, and category of registration.

I would also like to know if this role is staffed by police staff or Police Constables/ Detective Constables within your force.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

I can confirm that the role of Case Conference Attender is a Police Staff role.
The pay band is £25,758 – 27,690.
A copy of the role profile is attached.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
