Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request 2023.0690

On 03/07/2023 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

The information I am seeking is:

1. What information do you provide to third parties with regards to lost or stolen property?
2. Do you have a contract or any business agreements with companies such as RECIPERO to provide information from point 1?
3. How does a member of the public obtain access to the data sets containing lost or stolen property such as unique references or identifiers through yourselves?

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds no relevant information.

1. No information held. The Constabulary does not provide any information to 3rd parties with regard to stolen property as there is personal data linked. With regard to lost property, the items go to auction or the finder can claim the item after a given period.
2. No information held. The Constabulary does not have a contract with Recipero.
3. No information held. There is no mechanism for a member of the public to obtain access to information containing lost or stolen property. When items go to auction, the auctioneers publish a public facing list of the items.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information

Commissioner for consideration.
