Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request 2023.0892

On 06/09/2023 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

Under FOI 23.0803, I have received data that, between January 2015 and December 2019, a total of 11 persons aged 60 years and over were reported to you as victims of crime at Cheltenham General Hospital.

What data can you provide as to the nature of these reported crimes?

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Police Forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide statistics to government bodies and the recording criteria is set nationally. However, the systems used for recording these figures are not generic, nor are the procedures used locally in capturing the data. It should be noted that for these reasons the figures given relate to information from the specific recording system of Gloucestershire Constabulary and should not be used for comparison purposes with any other response you receive.

Please note that our systems are designed to record information for policing purposes and the investigation of crime and not to extract statistical information. Accordingly whilst we endeavour to extract relevant data within the time limits of the Act, any data supplied is subject to these limitations.

Following the previous request, and using the same search criteria of crimes recorded from 01/01/2015 to 31/07/2023 whereby the offence location was either Cheltenham General Hospital or Gloucestershire Royal Hospital and the victim was recorded as being aged 60 or over at the time of the offence, a breakdown of the data has been sought to

determine the offences recorded and the police outcomes for the years of 2015 – 2019, for Cheltenham General Hospital only as requested above.
