Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_24_0222

On 19/02/2024 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

What would you like to know?:

1. Since 2018 how many police officers have been investigated for criminal behaviour that is violent and or sexual.
2. How many were convicted in court.
3. How many police pensions were forfeited because of the subsequent conviction

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

1. I can confirm that the Constabulary has investigated 37 Police Officers for criminal behaviour with a violent/sexual element.
2. 4 were convicted.
3. No information held. The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC) are the Pension Supervising Authority for the Constabulary as detailed in The Police Pensions Regulations 2015. Details of how you can submit a FOI request to the OPCC can be found below:

Commissioner for consideration.
