Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_24_0598

On 19/06/2024 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

I am looking to update my research regarding what software solutions are currently used to manage and track vetting of police staff and would be most grateful if you would provide me, under the Freedom of Information Act, details in respect to the contract below.

The details I require are:

1. What, if any, software is used for managing and tracking vetting of police staff?
2. If purchased software is used, what was the start date, duration and value of the contract?
3. Is there an extension clause in the contract and, if so, the duration of the extension?
4. Has a decision been made yet on whether the contract is are being either extended or renewed?
5. Who is the senior person/s (outside of procurement) responsible for managing the force staff vetting process?

Please note I have reformatted your questions for ease.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

1. WPC Core-Vet solution, Core-DMS, Core-Vet Web Forms and Address Interface
2. Contract Started on 01/03/2021 and is valid for 24 months with options to extend for 12 months and then a further 12 months. £52,712 ex VAT inclusive of options to extend
3. As above
4. Extended: yes; renewed: not yet
5. Force Vetting Manager

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
