Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_24_0691

On 24/07/2024 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

Many thanks for your response. I can confirm that I would like to submit an amended request.

- 1) The number of reports of sexual assaults, harassment, voyeurism, upskirting or stalking in the last five years where the location of the allegation or offence occurred at the Hartpury College and University campus.
- 2) Please state the year and location(s) of the alleged offences.
- 3) Please state the outcomes, where known of each offence.
- 4) Please state the sex of the victim and the offender (where known) in each case.
- 5) Please state, where known, if the offender's gender identity was different to their sex at birth.

You have indicated in your previous response that you can retrieve this information through the Crime Recording System for the offences of Sexual assaults, harassment, voyeurism, upskirting or stalking within the time period of 01/07/2019 – 30/06/2024, using a freetext search within the location of 'Hartpury', 'Hartpury College' and 'Hartpury University'.

Excessive costs: If this request needs refining to make it possible for you to comply without incurring excessive costs (FOIA Section 12), please prioritise point 1 above, breaking the information down by date and type of offence.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Police Forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide statistics to government bodies and the recording criteria is set nationally. However, the systems used for recording these figures are not generic, nor are the procedures used locally in capturing the data. It should be noted that for these reasons the figures given relate to information from the specific recording system of Gloucestershire Constabulary and should not be used for comparison purposes with any other response you receive.

Please note that our systems are designed to record information for policing purposes and the investigation of crime and not to extract statistical information. Accordingly whilst we endeavour to extract relevant data within the time limits of the Act, any data supplied is subject to these limitations

Following receipt of your request, initial searches were conducted of the Crime Recording System for all substantiated crimes recorded between 01/07/2019 to 30/06/2024 where the offences are under the Home Office Categories as one of the following:

Sexual Assault on a male aged 13 and over

Exposure and Voyeurism

Sexual Assault on a female aged 13 and over

Harassment

Stalking

A filter has been applied to the above offences for the location where it contains 'Hartpury College' or 'Hartpury University'. This search has included the victims and offenders for the offences.

The results have been provided for closed cases.
