REQUEST 3:

What would you like to know?: Please could you provide me with a copy of whatever action plan Gloucestershire Constabulary had to action following the 2021 findings of His Majesties Inspector of Constabulary, and update me with whatever actions have been taken and what remains to be addressed?

If this information is available online, please could you provide a link as I have been unable to find it.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds no relevant information.

Following receipt of your request, I can confirm that your request has been sent to the relevant departments who have confirmed the following:

1. Overall the mounted unit have conducted 240 hours in the Stroud Local Police Area in 2022 – 2024.
2022 – 69.5
2023 – 97.5
2024 – 102 hours to date
2. No information held, the mounted unit have never been held in Stroud, they are county based.
3. No information held, there was no action plan created following the inspection. There were 44 recommendations or areas for Improvement in the HMICFRS Report, please see the below link:
