Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_24_0999

On 07/11/2024 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

Can you please provide a list of the number of arrests made by your force each day in December 2023 and also on 1st January 2024.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Police Forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide statistics to government bodies and the recording criteria is set nationally. However, the systems used for recording these figures are not generic, nor are the procedures used locally in capturing the data. It should be noted that for these reasons the figures given relate to information from the specific recording system of Gloucestershire Constabulary and should not be used for comparison purposes with any other response you receive.

Please note that our systems are designed to record information for policing purposes and the investigation of crime and not to extract statistical information. Accordingly whilst we endeavour to extract relevant data within the time limits of the Act, any data supplied is subject to these limitations.

A search was completed on our Arrest Recording System for the total number of arrests made daily from 01/12/23 – 01/01/2024. Please see the totals below
