On 15/12/2024 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

To whom it may concern,

Please provide the following information relevant to your Police Force between the dates of January 1st 2023 and December 15th 2024;

1. Have your police officers received training in the use of OIFR?
 - a. Provide all dates, locations of training
 - b. Provide details of those who were running training sessions/demonstrations
2. Has your police force deployed OIFR? If true;
 - a. Declare how many times it has been used, stating when and where.
3. Has your police force observed demonstrations of OIFR? If true;
 - a. Provide dates and locations of demonstrations
4. Has your police force tested OIFR? If true;
 - a. Provide dates and locations of testing
 - b. Was this testing done in private, or used on civilians
5. Does the police force have access to the OIFR app? If true;
 - a. State how long the police force has had access to the OIFR app

Furthermore, please also declare if there are future plans to deploy OIFR in your police force

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary does not hold some relevant information.
