Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_24_1126

On 15/12/24 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

How many domestic homicides have there been where the victims was killed by an ex-partner or current partner between the years of 2015 to 2023?

Of the domestic homicides recorded by your force between the years of 2015 to 2023, how many of the victims were categorised as

- Male

or

- Female

How many of the victims were aged between 18 to 45 between the years of 2015 to 2023?

Please supply the number of males or females who were killed by a partner or an ex-partner who had previous contact with your police force in the 12 months prior to their death.

(please could you supply an annual breakdown of this between the years 2020 to 2023)

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

A search has been conducted on substantiated crimes from 01.01.2020 – 31.12.2023 where the home office sub class of Homicide is present and the domestic abuse tag has been selected. A manual review has then been completed to confirm which of the victims were killed by an ex/current partner.

This resulted in 7 cases.

Of those 7 the gender of the victim is split by the following;

Male 2

Female 5

3 victims were aged 18-45

2 cases had contact with police 12 months prior to the death.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
