**Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request 2023.0169**

On 04/02/2023 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

Can you specify the time period on the 28/11/2022 that on the M5 Motorway northbound junction 10-9 a temporary 50 mph speed restriction was in place

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

The temporary 50 mph speed limit on the M5 Motorway northbound junction 10-9 came into force on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2022, meaning that the period of enforcement started at 00:01 on 16<sup>th</sup> November 2022 and lasted until the said likelihood "period of danger" had ended.

I can therefore confirm that on the date of 28<sup>th</sup> November 2022, the speed restriction was in place from 00:00 until 23:59 on the same date.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
