Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request 2023.0904

On 12/09/2023 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

I am looking to request information (under the Freedom of Information Act) regarding the THRIVE Model and the potential utilization of this particular strategy within your police service- Am I able to request information to support the following questions (?):

1. Do you use the THRIVE Model?
2. What thematic areas/ departments use the THRIVE Model? (e.g All departments, Intelligence units, Roads Policing, etc)
3. Do you have any framework for underpinning the assessments that are used for the THRIVE Model?
(A) If yes, please can we receive a copy?
4. Do you use these assessments to support any national functions (e.g meetings etc)?

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Following receipt of your request, enquiries were made with the relevant area of business and I can provide the following information;

1. Yes
2. All departments
3. No, there is no framework at this time

4. THRIVE+ is used by operational teams in relation to incidents and crimes. National functions which are operational. National functions that are not operational, such as performance monitoring or strategic, do not use THRIVE+ assessments

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
