Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_25_0013

On 07/01/2025 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

I write under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act, to request information on incident logs and crime reports. I am looking for all data in the last 15 years, between 2009 - to date.

- Over the last 15 years, how many complaints have you received about the company Alder King, or employees of Alder King?
- Over the same time period, how many complaints about Alder King (or its employees) related to allegations of fraud?
- In total, how many complaints about Alder King (or its employees) were investigated by you?
- In total, how many complaints relating to Alder King resulted in convictions?
- In total, how many complaints relating to Alder King were related to their business relationship with Lloyd's bank?

On 08/01/2025 we sought clarification.

We confirmed we would be unable to search for the occupation of "Alder King" due to our systems however, we could do a key search term of "Alder King" on our Crime and Incident Recording systems. You confirmed this would be sufficient.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Police Forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide statistics to government bodies and the recording criteria is set nationally. However, the systems used for recording these figures are not generic, nor are the procedures used locally in capturing the data. It should be noted that for these reasons the figures given relate to information from the specific recording system of Gloucestershire Constabulary and should not be used for comparison purposes with any other response you receive.

Please note that our systems are designed to record information for policing purposes and the investigation of crime and not to extract statistical information. Accordingly whilst we endeavour to extract relevant data within the time limits of the Act, any data supplied is subject to these limitations.

I can confirm a search has been conducted of our Crime Recording system from 01/01/2009 to 07/01/2025 whereby the term "Alder King" was mentioned in the comments. This has resulted in 0 crimes.

I can confirm a search has been conducted of our Incident Recording system from 01/01/2009 to 07/01/2025 whereby the term "Alder King" was mentioned in the comments. This has resulted in a handful of incidents however, after a manual review of these it has been determined that there were 0 relevant to your request.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
