Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_25_0098

On 24/01/2025 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

Q1: For the years 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 how many attempted murder or murder cases have been logged by your force where a bladed article purchased from 'DNA Leisure' was recorded as an element of the case?

Q2: For the years 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 how many attempted murder or murder cases have been logged by your force where a bladed article manufactured by 'Sporting Wholesale' was recorded as an element of the case?

Q3: For the years 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 how many attempted murder or murder cases have been logged by your force where a bladed article belonging to the knife brand Anglo Arms was recorded as an element of the case?

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds no relevant information.

A search was conducted for substantiated crimes for offences which fall under the sub class of Homicide for the dates of 01/01/2012 to 31/12/2024. A filter was added to the MO for the following keywords:

'DNA Leisure'

'Sporting Wholesale'

'Anglo Arms'

This returned zero results.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.
