Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_25_0122

On 01/02/2025 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

- Cycling on a footpath or causeway by the side of any road made or set apart for the use or accommodation of foot passengers
- Crossing a stop line when traffic lights are on red
- Failing to stop at a stop line on a road junction
- Cycling without appropriate lights between sunset and sunrise
- Cycling without reflectors between sunset and sunrise
- Cycling without legal brakes
- Cycling while under the influence of alcohol or drugs

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

From the offences provided our searches have found 1 offence of

- Ride a Cycle on a road/bridle way/footpath without due care and attention in the Local Policing Area of Cheltenham.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
