Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_25_0136

On 05/02/2025 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

Please provide details on the number of times the Gloucestershire Constabulary has exercised its powers under Section 60C of the Criminal Justice and Public Order Act 1994 (introduced by Police, Crime, Sentencing and Courts Act 2022 Sections 83 to 85) between 2022 and 2024.

Please provide details on number of times the Gloucestershire Constabulary has exercised its powers under Section 60D of the Criminal Justice and Public Order Act 1994 (introduced by Police, Crime, Sentencing and Courts Act 2022 Sections 83 to 85) between 2022 and 2024.

Does the Constabulary have a Gypsy Traveller Liaison Officer (GTLO) and/or a special point of contact (SPOC) for engaging Romani (Gypsy) and Irish Traveller communities?

Can you provide a role description of this officer if there is one?

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds no relevant information.

A search has been conducted of Gloucestershire Constabulary systems to identify any/all records where the Section 60C or Section 60D of the Criminal Justice and Public Order Act has been recorded. I can confirm that for the period of 01/01/2022 to 31/12/2024, no records have been returned.

Gloucestershire Constabulary does not have a GTLO, however I can advise you that this is a post held within Gloucestershire County Council.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
