Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_25_0174

On 11/02/2025 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

I am writing to you under the FOI Act 2000 to inquire about the following information:
Number of cases of voyeurism (088/10) offences and outcomes, with the following location types over the last 5 years:

PB Indoor sport area (exp. Swimming baths) PC Swimming Baths PE Leisure/Exhibition Centre

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Police Forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide statistics to government bodies and the recording criteria is set nationally. However, the systems used for recording these figures are not generic, nor are the procedures used locally in capturing the data. It should be noted that for these reasons the figures given relate to information from the specific recording system of Gloucestershire Constabulary and should not be used for comparison purposes with any other response you receive.

Please note that our systems are designed to record information for policing purposes and the investigation of crime and not to extract statistical information. Accordingly whilst we endeavour to extract relevant data within the time limits of the Act, any data supplied is subject to these limitations.

A search has been conducted of the Crime Recording System to identify all substantiated crimes recorded between 01/01/2020 and 31/12/2024 where the Home Office offence code of 088/10 – Voyeurism has been applied. MO Location codes can be added to a crime record to identify a type of location. A filter has been applied to the search results using the available codes of:

- SWIMMING BATHS
- LEISURE CENTRE
- SPORTS / LEISURE
