On 01.05.2025 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

How many incidents in High Street, Cheltenham, involving electric bikes have you had to deal with each year since, and including, 2020 and so far in 2025?

* Have any led to anyone being injured and, if so, were any serious injuries?

* Of those incidents, did any led to anyone being arrested and/or charged with any offences?

* Was anyone convicted and if so what were the sentences and what were the name, age and address of the offenders?

* Can I ask all the same questions, as above, about incidents in High Street, Cheltenham, involving e-scooters please.

Clarification was sought from you in which you confirmed the following:

Thanks for your help on the phone earlier this morning.

I've scoured the list for categories that might be relevant to offences involving electric bikes and e-scooters.

So please can you look under the following Home Office Codes:

004/12

004/18

004/19

005/11

008/04
068/23

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds no relevant information.

A search was conducted for all crimes from 01.01.2020 – 02.05.2025 where the following offences were present

004/12 - Causing Death or Serious Injury by Dangerous Driving
004/18 - Causing Death or Serious Injury by Driving: Unlicensed, Disqualified or Uninsured Drivers
004/19 - Causing Death or Serious Injury by careless or inconsiderate driving
005/11 - Endangering Life
008/04 - Assault with injury
068/23 - Other Offences against the State or public order

Of that data a filter was added to the MO for the following words

electric bikes,
e-scooters,
e-bikes
