Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_25_0973

On 07/10/2025 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following information.

I am requesting a breakdown of the total number of vehicle speeding offences recorded (offence count) in your Police Force area, as well as the measured speeds and vehicle make. We want to know how many speeding offences there were that exceeded 112mph

We request the data for the period 1 September 2024 to 31st August 2025 (or the most recent 12-month period that you can access).

To confirm, please provide me with:

1. A CSV (or Excel) table listing every recorded speeding enforcement where a speed was recorded (camera capture, traffic officer issue or TOR) between 1 September 2024 to 31st August 2025, including these fields:
 - date
 - time
 - location
 - vehicle manufacturer
 - recorded/measured speed (mph)
2. If you cannot provide the full table, please provide:
 - the number of recorded speeding offences where the measured speed was greater than 112 mph (same date range as above or most recent 12-month period)
 - and the total number of recorded speeding offences (any speed in the same period)

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary may hold some relevant information.

Following the receipt of your request, we have sourced this to our specialist teams within Gloucester constabulary who have conducted a search which has produced 0 results.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
