Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_25_1095

On 11/11/2025 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

I would like to know the following information please:

As of November 4 2025, or based on the most recent available figures:

- How many active or outstanding arrest warrants were held by your force?
- What offences were the warrants issued for?
- How many of the warrants were issued more than a year ago?
- What offences were the warrants issued more than a year ago issued for?

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Following receipt of your request, one of the Constabulary's subject matter experts (SMEs) conducted a search for the active/outstanding warrants you requested. The information retrieved can be found below.

As of November 4 2025, or based on the most recent available figures:

- 28/07/2026
- How many active or outstanding arrest warrants were held by your force?
 - 449
- What offences were the warrants issued for?

- *A single warrant can be issued for multiple offences linked to a single case. As a result, we do not hold details on our local records management system of the specific offences the warrant was issued for. We do however categorise all warrants received using the NPCC Matrix Guidance for the grading of Fail to Appear Warrants & Warrant in First Instance, which would give all warrants a grading of A, B, or C.*
- How many of the warrants were issued more than a year ago?
 - 243
- What offences were the warrants issued more than a year ago issued for?
 - *Please see details of information held above.*

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
