Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_25_1178

On 07/12/2025 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

I am researching the outcomes of the Op Snap program, and have been unable to find recent statistics in the data section on your website, or in other FOI archives.

I would be grateful if you could provide a breakdown of the reports you have received in the last 12 months of data available to you, broken down by the month of the report, the type of report/offence (e.g. red light, mobile phone use), and the outcome (e.g. warning letter, FPN, NFA).

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Police Forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide statistics to government bodies, and the recording criteria is set nationally. However, the systems used for recording these figures are not generic, nor are the procedures used locally in capturing the data. It should be noted that for these reasons the figures given relate to information from the specific recording system of Gloucestershire Constabulary and should not be used for comparison purposes with any other response you receive.

Please note that our systems are designed to record information for policing purposes and the investigation of crime and not to extract statistical information. Accordingly, whilst we endeavour to extract relevant data within the time limits of the Act, any data supplied is subject to these limitations.

Following searches, the breakdown of the reports received by the Constabulary in the period your requested, broken down by the month of the report, the type of report & offence and the outcome are provided.
