Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_25_1195

On 14/12/2025 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

Please may you provide me with:

- The total number of arrests your police force made in the last calendar year for sexual offences. Can this data be broken down by nationality (eg. Albanian, Russian etc.)
- The total number of arrests your police force made in the last calendar year for drug offences. Can this data be broken down by nationality
- The total number of arrests your police force made in the last calendar year for fraud offences. Can this data be broken down by nationality

Please provide the information in Excel format. Please do not provide PDF word as this makes my life much more difficult.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Following receipt of your request, a search was conducted by one of the Constabulary's subject matter experts of the arrest recording system for the last calendar year leading up to and including 14/12/2025. The search was conducted for the arrests recorded for sexual offences, drug offences and fraud offences, all broken down by nationality of offender.

Police Forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide statistics to government bodies, and the recording criteria is set nationally. However, the systems used for recording these figures are not generic, nor are the procedures used locally in capturing the data. It should be noted that for these reasons the figures given relate to information from the specific recording system of Gloucestershire Constabulary and should not be used for comparison purposes with any other response you receive.

Please note that our systems are designed to record information for policing purposes and the investigation of crime and not to extract statistical information. Accordingly, whilst we endeavour to extract relevant data within the time limits of the Act, any data supplied is subject to these limitations.

As requested, a separate Excel document is attached (25_1995 Arrest and Nationality Information) for your information.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
