Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_25_1020

On 19/10/2025 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

I would like to know how many FOI requests you have had in the last year from the date of this request relating to Terrorism Acts and how many you have declined to answer on the grounds of legal exemption.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

A search has been conducted of the FOI request log for the term "Terrorism". This identified all requests received where the word is present within the body of the text.

For the period of 19/10/2024 to 18/10/2025, I can confirm that 6 FOI requests have been received that are relevant to your request.

Due to the wording of each request, and the specific information requested, not all have been answered in the same manner.

- 4 responses were to confirm information is held, but to fully exempt that information by virtue of Section 24 – National Security and Section 31 – Law enforcement.
- 1 response was to confirm information is held, some of which was provided, but a breakdown of the data was exempt by virtue of Section 40 – Personal Information.
- 1 response was refused on the grounds of cost, engaging Section 12.

Please note that part way through the date range requested, there was a change to the national stance for the disclosure of information relating to the Terrorism Act, meaning that where some information was previously exempt, it may now be disclosable.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
