Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_26_0091

On 20/01/2026 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

1. List the police officers dismissed or who have resigned from your force following conviction of a crime
2. For each officer listed in your answer to Q1, itemise them to show if they were dismissed or resigned, gender, offence(s), year of conviction, and if their pension has been forfeited (if so, include % forfeited).

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Following searches, the information below is provided in response to your questions:

Gender				
Officer 1	Male	Make indecent photograph/pseudo-photograph of a child	2019	Would have been dismissed
Officer 2	Male	Theft	2019	Dismissal
Officer 3	Male	Assault	2021	Would have been dismissed
Officer 4	Male	Driving a motor vehicle with excess alcohol	2022	Dismissal
Officer 5	Male	Driving a motor vehicle with excess alcohol	2023	Dismissal
Officer 6	Female	Sexual activity with a child	2024	Dismissal

Officer 7	Male	Driving whilst disqualified and driving without third party insurance	2024	Would have been dismissed
Officer 8	Female	Misconduct in a public office	2024	Would have been dismissed
Officer 9	Male	Obtain or disclose personal data without consent of controller	2024	Would have been dismissed

Please note that 'would have been dismissed' refers to officers who resigned/retired before their hearing which later found that they would have been dismissed had they not resigned/retired. Regarding pensions, no forfeitures have been obtained.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
