I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 regarding red light cameras within your jurisdiction of Cheltenham. Please provide the following details:

1. The total number of fixed red light cameras currently operational in Cheltenham.
2. The specific locations (road names/junctions) of these cameras.
3. The number of red light violations recorded at these sites from 1st January 2026 to the present date.

If you do not hold this information, please confirm if it is held by Gloucestershire County Council or another body.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds no relevant information.

I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary does not have any active red light cameras in the Force Area and hasn't had in the time period specified above.
