Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_26_0259

On 06/03/2026 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

My request concerns corruption-related intelligence.

1. For each calendar year 2023, 2024, and 2025, please provide the total number of sexual misconduct cases you recorded.
2. For each calendar year 2023, 2024, and 2025, please provide the number of sexual misconduct cases you recorded as abuse of position for a sexual purpose (APSP).
3. For each calendar year 2023, 2024, and 2025, please provide the total number of reports you received through the national Crimestoppers integrity line.
4. For each calendar year 2023, 2024, and 2025, please provide the number of reports you received through the national Crimestoppers integrity line concerning abuse of position for a sexual purpose (APSP).

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Searches were made of Gloucestershire Constabulary's database for misconduct cases in 2023, 2024 and 2025 regarding sexual misconduct and sexual misconduct where abuse of position for a sexual purpose had been identified. Further searches were conducted to locate the number of Crimestoppers reports received through the integrity line and those which concerned abuse of position for a sexual purpose. In response to the questions you asked, the following below can be shared.

Police Forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide statistics to government bodies, and the recording criteria is set nationally. However, the systems used for recording these figures are not generic, nor are the procedures used locally in capturing the data. It should be noted that for these reasons the figures given relate to information from the specific recording system of Gloucestershire Constabulary and should not be used for comparison purposes with any other response you receive.

Please note that our systems are designed to record information for policing purposes and the investigation of crime and not to extract statistical information. Accordingly, whilst we endeavour to extract relevant data within the time limits of the Act, any data supplied is subject to these limitations.
