On 14/04/2026 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

Please can you provide me with the following information under the freedom of information act:

1. Your criteria for the offering of a driver awareness course in relation to speeding offences
2. Your criteria for the offering of a driver awareness course in relation to red light offences
3. Your criteria for the offering of a driver awareness course in relation to driving without due care and attention offences
4. For each of the above whether or not driver awareness courses are offered to new drivers (those within 2 years of passing their first driving test)

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Q1)

Speed Limit	Speed Awareness offer
20 mph	25 - 31 mph
30 mph	35 - 42 mph
40 mph	46 - 53 mph
50 mph	57 - 64 mph

60 mph	68 - 75 mph
70 mph	79 - 86 mph

Q2) Light showing up to 3 seconds of it turning red and not have attended a similar NDORS course in the past three years.

Q3) Course offered after a review & if no previous attendance in the past 3 years of a similar NDORS course.

Q4) All driver awareness courses are offered to new drivers.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
