Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_26_0387

On 21/04/2026 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

1. For each of the last three financial years (2023/24) (2024/25) and (2025/26) please state the number of female arrests for the offence of being "drunk and disorderly" (Section 91 Criminal Justice Act 1967), broken down by:
2. Of these arrests, please provide a breakdown by age group (i) under 30 and (ii) 30 and over
3. If held, please provide the number of these arrests that resulted in (i) charge/summons, or (ii) and out-of-court disposal (including community resolution)
4. For each of the last three financial years (2023/24) (2024/25) and (2025/26) please state the number of female arrests for public order offences, including offences under Sections 4, 4A and 5 of the Public Order Act 1986, broken down by those aged (i) under 30 and (ii) aged 30 or over.

Please provide the data in Excel format if possible.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Police Forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide statistics to government bodies, and the recording criteria is set nationally. However, the systems used for recording these figures are not generic, nor are the procedures used locally in capturing the data. It should be noted that for these reasons the figures given relate to information from the specific recording system of Gloucestershire Constabulary and should not be used for comparison purposes with any other response you receive.

Please note that our systems are designed to record information for policing purposes and the investigation of crime and not to extract statistical information. Accordingly, whilst we endeavour to extract relevant data within the time limits of the Act, any data supplied is subject to these limitations.

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted of the Constabulary's recorded detentions. As Gloucestershire Constabulary records arrests under specific reason for arrest (RFA) codes, not by Parliamentary Act, it was not possible to refine the data exactly how you requested. A search was conducted for the date range 01/04/2023 to 09/02/2026 for female arrests using the RFA "Drunk Disorderly/Public Order" under which the following categories sit:

- Drunk And Disorderly
- Public Order Disorderly Conduct
- Public Order Harassment
- Public Order Threat Words
- Public Order Other

Using this search, the information below can be shared in response to your request:

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
