Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_26_0395

On 27/04/2026 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

How many officers took sick leave for depression, anxiety, stress or post-traumatic stress between April 2025 and March 2026. By this, I mean where any of the term's depression, anxiety, stress or post-traumatic stress appear in the description of the officer's illness.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds the relevant information.

Over the period specified April 2025 and March 2026. There are 54 officers with at least one absence of either anxiety, depression, stress or PTSD.

If you are not satisfied with this response or any actions taken in dealing with your request, you have the right to ask that we review your case under our internal procedure. Please note that a request for an internal review must be made within 20 working days of the response to your original request.

If you decide to request that such a review is undertaken and following this process you are still unsatisfied, you then have the right to direct your complaint to the Information Commissioner for consideration.
