Gloucestershire Constabulary Freedom of Information request FOI_26_0398

On 24/04/2026 you sent an email constituting a request under the Freedom of Information Act asking the following:

I would be grateful if you could furnish me with the following information via the Freedom of Information Process.

The purpose of the information is for a piece of work for the Centre of Justice Innovation which is funded by the Jabbs Foundation

Please provide me with a copy of the following information:

1. The total number of adult women arrested with breakdown of their ethnic group in your police service area for the financial year 2024/2025
2. The total number of Community Resolutions with breakdown by ethnic group for this same group of adult women arrested in 2024/25

I would prefer to receive this information in electronic format (e.g., CSV or PDF) via email.

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 s1, I can confirm that Gloucestershire Constabulary holds some relevant information.

Police Forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide statistics to government bodies, and the recording criteria is set nationally. However, the systems used for recording these figures are not generic, nor are the procedures used locally in capturing the data. It should be noted that for these reasons the figures given relate to information from the specific recording system of Gloucestershire Constabulary and should not be used for comparison purposes with any other response you receive.

Please note that our systems are designed to record information for policing purposes and the investigation of crime and not to extract statistical information. Accordingly, whilst we endeavour to extract relevant data within the time limits of the Act, any data supplied is subject to these limitations.

Following receipt of your request, a search was conducted of the Constabulary's detention records for adult women arrested between 01/04/2024 and 31/03/2025. A further filter was applied to search for the offence decision of community resolution. The data in response to your questions is shared below.
