Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I am requesting the following information from your constabulary:

1. How many police officers made no arrests during the periods of:

(a) 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024

(b) 1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025

(c) 1 April 2025 to 31 March 2026

2. How many police officers made fewer than 5 arrests in the same periods of a), b) and c)?

3. What was the total number of police officers (FTE) in this constabulary as of 1 April 2023, 1 April 2024 and 1 April 2025?

Please provide the data in a spreadsheet format if possible.

If any part of this request is unclear or too broad, I would be grateful if you could contact me to refine it. If any information is held but exempt from disclosure, please outline the relevant exemption and your justification for its use.

I understand that under Section 10(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, a response is required within 20 working days of receipt of this request.
